

## CAIRNS CRUISING YACHT SQUADRON – CLUBHOUSE BY-LAWS

The CCYS has a clubhouse provided to the benefit of members and promotion of the sport of sailing. These by-laws should be applied to all use of the clubhouse and surrounds. Failure to comply with these By-laws may see your membership suspended or terminated as per our constitution.

This is a members' Club and priority must be given to members. The Clubhouse premises should present a welcoming and convivial atmosphere for members and their guests.

CCYS supports a downstairs members' bar, restaurant, BBQ area and a second floor function room which incorporates a bar and verandah. A members' library is also available.

### **Clubhouse**

1. The clubhouse lawns and surrounds are a licensed premise.
2. The bar and licensed areas will at all times operate in accordance with the Liquor Act and by-laws of the CCYS.
3. Bar operation to be in accordance with Liquor Licensing Laws
4. Bar trading hours will be as advertised on the front of the building and may change from time to time to cater for patronage.
5. No liquor shall be brought on to the licensed premises.
6. No food shall be brought on to the licensed premises during the restaurant trading hours.
7. No food shall be consumed in the dedicated outdoor smoking area.
8. No credit is to be offered to members or guests for food or beverages. The exception is the Commodore's Account which may be used for legitimate entertainment costs relating to the promotion of the CCYS or its members
9. Any person attending clubhouse facilities must be suitably attired and behave in a socially acceptable manner.
10. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times. Persons not correctly attired will not be served and will be asked to leave the premises.
11. Drunken or disorderly behavior will not be accepted, and persons may be asked to leave the premises.
12. Management reserves the right to refuse entry or service to any patron.
13. If the behaviour is such that intervention may, or is suspected to, increase the anti-social behaviour then the police/security officer should be called to remove offenders who may then be called upon to show cause why their membership should not be suspended.

### **Function Room**

14. Members will receive a \$50.00 discount for bookings of the function room.
15. Management may use discretion to vary rates in compiling a package for hiring. They may also vary basic liquor prices up or down when approving a function package.
16. Any person hiring any part of the clubhouse is responsible for their guests' behavior

### **Members BBQ**

17. Members' use of the BBQ area shall be free of charge.
18. The BBQ cannot be used during restaurant trading hours unless agreed to by management.
19. The BBQ and surrounding area must be kept clean by users.
