

CAIRNS CRUISING YACHT SQUADRON – MARINA BY-LAWS

Marina berths are provided for the benefit of members. By-laws are designed to eliminate inconvenience to other users and management. Failure to comply with these By-laws may see your membership suspended or terminated as per our constitution.

Marina By-laws

1. The Marina facility is to be used by members only.
2. No person shall moor a vessel at any berth except by prior arrangement.
3. Owners of vessels moored in the marina do so at their own risk.
4. A written request for use of a marina berth shall be lodged with the CCYS office by completing a 'Permit To Occupy' form.
5. Mooring fees are to be paid in advance. Fees are calculated on the overall length of the vessel and fittings. (see schedule of fees).
6. A waiting list for berths shall kept in the CCYS office.
7. Marina berth D7 is a full time designated Courtesy Berth for short term loading and unloading. Maximum stay is 45 minutes.
8. Vessels must leave the courtesy berth immediately if directed to do so by the Clubhouse Manager or a member of the Board of Directors.
9. Unauthorised overnight stays on the courtesy berth will incur a \$100 fee.
10. Marina berths may be required from time to time for CCYS events/activities. No one month term will be booked in conflict with these event dates. A berth may be booked for the period up to the event date. Any vessels required to vacate shall be eligible to return after the event. Rates for participants in approved events are set in conjunction with the event.
11. All outside berths may be used for Friday night sailing events and approved sailing calendar events to allow participating yachts to raft alongside to load and unload CCYS guests. Appropriate use of fenders is advised.
12. No vessel shall moor with overhangs of the walkways.
13. No member may sublet any marina berth.
14. All marina users must comply with CCYS Environmental License conditions. No spray painting, sanding, grinding is permitted on any marina berth.
15. Internal repairs may be undertaken with the approval of the Board of Directors.
16. No dinghy's are to be moored in the marina, except at the designated dinghy areas.
17. Where shore power is required, CCYS responsibility ends at the power box on the marina.
18. All power leads should be kept in a safe condition.
19. No pollution of the waterway is permitted. Disposal of all waste is to be in the appropriate receptacles.
20. A person shall not navigate recklessly or carelessly in the marina area.
21. No fishing by spear gun, net or line is permitted in the marina.
22. Engines may only be operated in the marina in daylight hours. No engine may be operated in gear while the vessel is still tied to the marina.
23. All pontoons shall be kept clear of obstructions. A step may be kept for boarding assistance.
24. Vessels mooring to outside berths shall occupy the end of the berth as near as practicable.
