CAIRNS CRUISING YACHT SQUADRON - MEMBERSHIP BY-LAWS

CCYS offers membership to all persons who have an interest in boating activities. These by-laws have been produced to ensure fairness and equality for all members. CCYS facilities are provided on a 'user-pays' basis to authorised persons, with discounts available for current members where decided by the Board. CCYS provides many social and educational events and encourages participation of its members and their guests.

Membership By-laws

- 1 Applicants must complete the appropriate form and provide all information requested therein.
- 2 New applications must include the names, membership number and signature of both the Proposer and Seconder. (Clause 12.7 CCYS Constitution)
- 3 The application together with the prescribed fees (see Schedule of fees) must be lodged with CCYS Administration/Secretary
- 4 Applicants who are granted and accept membership of CCYS agree to be bound by the CCYS Constitution and By-laws
- 5 The applicant/s will be put on a 3 month probation period. Members who do not comply with or disregard the CCYS constitution or By-laws may be addressed by the Board (clause 12.11 CCYS Constitution) or have their membership revoked immediately.
- 6 Members shall not use their membership privileges for personal gain or advantage other than recreational/educational benefit.
- 7 The privileges and obligations of CCYS membership become effective immediately upon receiving membership card after Board approval.
- 8 The CCYS membership is for 1 year from the date of application.
- 9 All annual membership fees are due and payable the first day of the new membership year
- 10 CCYS will issue renewal notices to all members within the first 10 calendar days of the preceding month of the due date.
- 11 A discount may be offered to members who pay their fees before renewal date. Such discounts will be shown on renewal notices.
- 12 A 'grace period' of one month from renewal date will be allowed for payment of membership fees, during which time membership privileges and entitlements shall remain.
- 13 Memberships that remain unpaid after 1 month 'grace period' from the renewal date will have their membership cancelled, and will be required to re-apply for membership.
- 14 CCYS provides and maintains a data base which includes ownership details, insurance and vessel specifications of member vessels,
- 15 Only CCYS registered vessels may display the letters "CCYS" on their vessel, or fly club burgee
- 16 CCYS vessel registration includes indemnity of CCYS and RFS for and during use of CCYS facilities
- 17 CCYS vessel data base shall be made available to affiliated clubs where such vessel intends to visit, use or partake in that club's facilities

Classes of Membership

Full Member shall be a person over the age of 18 years who shall be entitled to take part in the management of CCYS and to vote at meetings and who shall be entitled to all the privileges and subject to all the obligations of CCYS membership.

Family Member shall be a single family unit consisting of 2 persons over the age of 18 years who shall be entitled to take part in the management of CCYS and to vote at meetings and who shall be entitled to all the privileges and subject to all the obligations. Family memberships shall include children up to 18 years of age, but such children shall have no voting or management rights.

Associate Crew Member shall be a person over the age of 18 years who shall be entitled some of the privileges as determined by the Board and subject to all the obligations of CCYS. Such associate member shall not be entitled to take part in the management of CCYS and cannot vote at meetings.

Absentee Membership is only available after 12 months of full membership and subject to conditions and approval of the Board

Temporary Member shall be a person over the age of 18 years. Period of membership is max of 3 months, the fee includes dinghy permit sticker. Temporary Members shall not be entitled to take part in the management of CCYS and cannot vote at meetings.
